Norway should be a place where people feel safe and happy to grow old. Therefore, KrF wants to implement a system where relatives can help receive support to help their elderly family members. Moreover, we want to strengthen the development of nursing homes home services for the elderly.

Secure health care when you need it

Norway must have a sound healthcare system that can provide the right help at the right time. In Norway today, many healthcare workers are overworked and burnt out. KrF wants to increase recruitment in the healthcare sector and create better working conditions for healthcare personnel.

Vibrant local communities with good jobs

KrF wants to create better conditions for locally-rooted businesses that create safe workplaces and contribute to building local communities nationwide. We want a viable agricultural industry that provides increased food production, better farmer income development, and strengthened environmental protection.

A good transition from kindergarten to school

An excellent start to school lays the foundation for many vital years in a child's life. KrF wants to ensure there are more teachers in schools and kindergartens in Norway. Also, we want to replace the first grade with a preschool class where playing, safety and relationships have a central place.

A fun and safe upbringing for children

KrF will introduce a "national leisure card" that allows all children and young people to participate in social activities like sports, music groups, or other clubs they may be interested in – for free! More and more young people today struggle with mental health challenges, and therefore KrF believes that the age limit for social media must be respected and that companies must be held responsible for this. KrF also believes that children should not use mobile phones during school hours.

Human dignity in all phases of life

We will fight for human dignity in all phases of life. No one should be excluded based on their abilities or qualities. KrF wants to give, therefore, better support for those who have children with special needs. We also want to provide more legal protection for babies before birth and we are against euthanasia.

We will support the non-profit sector within, among other things, drug rehabilitation, children's services and youth work for those in difficult situations. We believe the non-profit sector is important for preventing and helping people in vulnerable situations.
